S4-S6 SENIOR PHASE OPTIONS FORM

Please find attached the range of study options available throughout the Senior Phase. Below are specific instructions for different year groups. If you have any questions about the options or about the completion of the form, please contact your son/daughter's Principal Teacher of Guidance. Please note that the running of all courses is subject to available staffing. Further guidance on options will be available at our Senior Phase Options Information Evening on Thursday 15th February.

Forms submitted without reserve options will be returned so these can be added. Please note that we cannot guarantee that every combination of courses will be possible or that every course listed above will run. This will depend on the number of pupils opting for the course and on available staffing. Please note that late submission of forms may affect subjects allocated.

S4: All S4 pupils will study English and either Mathematics or Applications of Mathematics for certification at National 3, 4 or 5. They will also study core subjects of Personal Social Education, Physical Education and Religious, Moral and Philosophical Studies. They then choose 4 additional subjects from the list.

Please note that we are asking for the subject only, you should not indicate the level. However levels are provided for information as some subjects are only available at certain levels and may be inappropriate for some pupils. Please note that Highers (S5/6) and Advanced Highers (S6) are not usually available to S4 pupils since these provide progression beyond National courses in S4.

S5: All pupils should choose 5 subjects plus Enrichment.

S6: All pupils should choose a minimum of 4 subjects plus Enrichment. Pupils who haven't achieved 5 qualifications at level 5 should choose 5 subjects plus enrichment.

For both years, please indicate the level at which you wish to study (although this will be finally determined by previous attainment and progress throughout the year) in consultation with subject teachers.
