

Dear parents/carers.

I hope that this email finds you well. Further to the letter from Mr Morrison yesterday, this letter will give further detail to the online learning and teaching that begins on Monday for all pupils.

For S1 and S2 pupils, after feedback from parents, pupils and staff, the delivery model we used last session was well received. It was agreed that certain subjects would post their work on certain days to help pupils manage their working week. Although subjects will post work on set days, this does not mean pupil necessarily need to complete it then, but it will certainly help give some structure and allow pupils to manage their time. Guidance staff and class teachers will be online at other times and may respond to communications within the Teams, but pupils should not expect a response immediately.

### S1:

Day	Subjects

Thursday	Modern Languages, RMPS, PE and PSE

### S2:

Day	Subjects
Monday	Maths, English, Music, Design & Technology
Tuesday	Modern Languages, Art, ICT, History
Wednesday	Maths, English, Drama, Home Economics
Thursday	Modern Languages, RMPS, PE and PSE, Modern Studies
Friday	Maths, English, Geography, Science

### S3:

For S3 pupils, subjects will deliver a 30-minute online session at a time according to when the pupil would usually have that subject during the week but only at this one specific time will the teacher be online for 'live' interaction. This time will be communicated by each teacher in the Team and we would encourage pupils to then create a timetable or online calendar for themselves to follow.

For S3 Core subjects (PE, PSE), delivery will be more general with any tasks set in Teams and communication happening as and when required. S3 RMPS will have a live session during period 2 on a Monday.

For S3 pupils working with Aberdeen FC Community Trust, their tutors will be in touch via Microsoft Teams.

### Senior Phase (S4-S6):

Senior Phase pupils in S4, S5 and S6 will also follow a structure to their online learning where teachers will schedule two 30-minute sessions within the times pupils would normally be in that class. **Exact details will be shared with pupils in Teams/Classrooms** and the full school timetable can be found on the school website [here](#). Again, we would encourage pupils to create a timetable for their online learning to help them manage tasks.

Senior Phase RMPS is timetabled for a contact period during what would be period 3 on a Wednesday.

S5 Employability will have an interactive session on a Wednesday period 5

S6 Leadership will have an interactive session on a Wednesday period 6.

For pupils studying Foundation Apprenticeships with external partners/providers, online classes are likely to continue via Teams at the usual period times.

Instead of PSE lessons, Guidance teachers will be seeing pupils on a one-to-one basis on Monday and Wednesday afternoons. Communication via Teams will continue at all other times.

I appreciate the fact that home environments are different for everyone and that not all pupils will be able to log in online at exact times for some sessions but all work being covered will be saved and shared in pupil Teams or Glow for pupils to access at any time.

Many thanks for your continued patience and support at what is a challenging start to the new year.
