Education Maintenance Allowance

Para 1 - General

Students aged 16+ and staying on in school may be eligible for an Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA). EMA is a payment of £30 per week to assist students with the costs of staying in education for 5th and 6th year. That's up to £1200 for the academic year! Awards are based on taxable household income, and you must be following a minimum 21 hour per week guided learning programme. Para2 – General (alternative version)

Education Maintenance Allowance: a financial scheme applicable to students aged between 16 and 19 whose household income does not exceed a certain amount, and who attend school regularly for a minimum of 21 hours guided learning per week. Students that meet all the criteria could get £30 per week paid directly to their bank account. Para 3 - For Students

Para 4 – For Parents/Guardians

If your taxable household income is less than £24,421 (1 dependent child in the household) or £26,884 (more than 1 dependent child in the household) and you have a child aged 16+ staying on at School, your child could be eligible for an Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA). This is a payment of £30 per week paid directly into your child's bank account, providing they meet the requirements of the EMA. This does not affect any benefits you currently receive.
