Some of the main issues that staff deal with on a regular basis:

- Phone out in class without permission
- Someone taking a photo without other person's permission
- Someone posting on social media without other person's permission
- Discrete (or not so discrete) bullying through 'banter' (TES article)

The majority of these things happen in social times and in the community but naturally spill into school time and have an effect on the pupils.

Some steps we use to inform our pupils of appropriate use:

- Through PSE lessons
- Assemblies promoting responsible use
- Whole school focus weeks through Daily Contact Time

- Encourage positive use (eg Keyboarding, word processing, coding)
- Screen free time






