Parental Employability and Financial Support Campaign

Parent Club has launched a new campaign to help families who were already struggling and are now feeling completely overwhelmed by the additional pressures brought on by the current economic crisis.

Campaign Overview

The campaign raises awareness of the support that is available on the [Parent Club website](#). Parents and carers will find advice and be guided to trusted advisors, and these Money Talk Team and Local Authority Employment advisors offer free confidential advice to those with money or employment worries.

This campaign follows on from the Cost-of-Living campaign activity which launched in September 2022. However, the Parent Club campaign differs as it is targeting low income families specifically, guiding
