Attainment, Qualifications and Achievement

Learning and Teaching

To promote the best teaching and learning for pupils by supporting and developing teachers to be knowledgeable, confident and skilled and who improve the attainment, qualifications and achievement of all our pupils.

Leadership

To develop leadership skills, experiences and potential for everyone in our school.

Equality and Inclusion

To provide fairness and equal opportunity in all aspects of school life. To allow all pupils to access the same level of education and to allow all pupils opportunities beneficial to their own interest and needs and to have the same opportunities as everyone else but have your own individual learning style catered for.

Values and Citizenship

To work with pupils, parents and employees to promote self-respect and respect for each other. To help pupils understand the duties and responsibilities of citizenship in society.

To equip pupils for life beyond school with positive attitudes and expectations, encourage creativity, ambition and entrepreneurial skills and the resilience that will help them prosper in our changing society.
