As we look ahead to Session 2024-25, below are some key updates and reminders for all.

• Education Scotland – Inspection Update and Next Steps

Since we received our Inspection Report and feedback a number of months ago, myself, the Senior Leadership Team and all school staff have been working hard on identifying and agreeing our next steps across the school, to meet the requirements from Education Scotland colleagues.

This has involved lots of strategy meetings, discussions, and additional action planning sessions, with on-going support from our Quality Improvement Manager from the local authority. I have also been working closely with our Parent Council and have updated them on several different occasions. The most recent and more detailed update can be found in the slides below:

Going forwards, I plan to share monthly updates with all parents/carers about our progress to date. Our first bulletin will be with you in the new term, and we will continue to update Parent Council at forthcoming meetings as we go.

• SQA Update / Course Changes

Mrs Campbell-Robertson (Depute Head Teacher / SQA Co-ordinator) is writing to all Senior Phase parents and carers about the SQA process for this session with important information. This will also include information from our Guidance Team about requesting any changes to subjects or courses, with a Microsoft Form to complete prior to returning to school in August 2024.

Pupils will receive their much-anticipated SQA Results on Tuesday 6th August 2024, and we wish them all the very best. I am sure they will make us very #ProudOfPorty!

• Uniform

It has been fantastic to see an improvement in our School Uniform across the school since the change of timetable; a particular thanks to our new Senior Pupils who have made such a difference. Many pupils have taken the information on board and are wearing appropriate school uniform each day. Thank you and well done!

However, for some, there is still some room for improvement and, contrary to what your young person may tell you – it does matter! In particular, the bottom half of uniform still needs addressed for many pupils please, namely in not wearing leggings or joggers to school as these are not appropriate for the workplace. With the increase in warmer weather, several pupils are also wearing crop tops to school, which is also unacceptable, and needs addressed as a matter of urgency, as this is equally not suitable for school or the workplace.

Below is what is accepted in our school dress code, and I would ask you to please address this with your young person over the summer break to ensure they are equipped with appropriate school uniform for our return in August. White collars and ties should also be worn each day. Pupils should change every period for PE and wear uniform out with PE times.

We will be monitoring this closely and will be in touch with you as parents/carers in the new session if there continue to be concerns. Thank you for your support with this.

Expectations of All

Tie –

Junior (S1-3) – School Colours Senior (S4-6) – Black *Available from School Office

• White collar – shirt/polo shirt

Plain black jumper, v-neck, cardigan if extra layer needed.

- Black trousers, black smart shorts, skirt, jeans
- Black/dark trainers or shoes

Not Accepted

- Leggings / Joggers / Sports Wear / Crop Tops
- Jackets and hats/hoods (to be removed in school/workplace).
- Bright / coloured trainers or shoes.

If there are any exceptions or exemptions required for medical/additional support need (ASN)/sensory issues, then please contact your young person's Guidance Teacher for a further discussion. Equally, if support is required, then there is funding available for those eligible here: School clothing grants - Aberdeenshire Council
