## Change to Pupil Support at Portlethen Academy

At Portlethen Academy we currently operate a Year Head System. Each young person is in their House Group, with a designated Principal Teacher of Guidance (PTG), who looks after their wellbeing and is the main point of contact. When there are concerns around attendance, behaviour, welfare etc, the Year Head, (one of the Depute Head Teachers), steps in to support the PTG and will often get in touch with home or lead child's plan meetings with young people and families.

Operating a Year Head system means that each of our Guidance Teachers needs to liaise with several different members of the Senior Leadership Team in order to meet the needs of our young people. We have four full time Depute positions at Portlethen Academy, but as there are two job-share positions within the team, this means each Guidance Teacher has to speak to six different Deputes to resolve issues or put plans into place for targeted supports and interventions.

In order to improve our GIRFEC (Getting it Right for Every Child) approaches, improve consistency and efficiency, and make things easier for families with more than one child in school at a time, we are going to be moving from a Year Head System to a House Head System from the start of Term 1 in August 2024. This means that each Guidance Teacher will work solely with one Depute Head Teacher or one Job Share team of Depute Head Teachers. Instead of being a Year Head for a year group, Deputes will now be a House Head for a house group. These will be as follows:

For pupils and families, all this means is that rather than having a Year Head within the Senior Leadership Team, each young person will now have a House Head instead. The exact same processes will be in place but responses to issues and effectiveness of GIRFEC will improve due to their being a dedicated team for each house group.
